Language Development (Abeka):

Recognition of name and sound of all letters
language skills that deal with science, health, safety, manners, community helpers, geography, history, family, colors, shapes, numbers

Pre-Writing (Handwriting Without Tears):

Vertical and Horizontal
Big and Little Curves
Diagonal lines
Trace
Introduction to pencil grip

Social Studies/Science (Abeka):

Thematic units are used weekly to develop Language and listening skills. (i.e. Health and Safety, Manners, Weather, Space, Insects, Transportation, Animals, etc.). Art projects, crafts and hands-on activities are incorporated to re-enforce the information learned in each unit.
