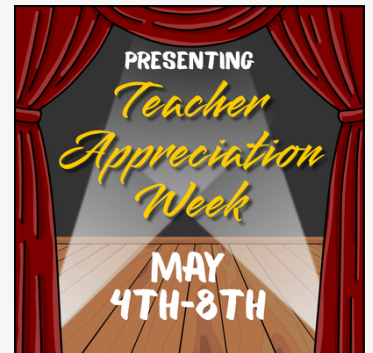
May the Fourth Be With You

When the online store becomes available again, you can place your order by visiting our website. Simply navigate to the top menu, click on "**School Life**," then select "**Yearbook**" to be directed to the ordering page.

This celebration will include a graduation-style processional for each student, along with performances by our school band. Before School Drop Off

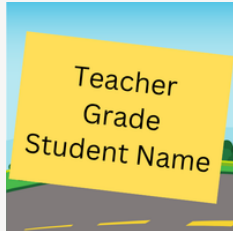


Parents, please be reminded that **students may not go to their classroom until after 8:10**. If your child needs to be dropped off earlier, we have early morning care starting at **7 am**. Anytime between 7 and 7:45 will be a \$5 fee. **There is no charge after 7:45 am**.

Children in Pre-K and Kindergarten will go to the choir room, and children in 1st - 6th grades will go to the fellowship hall until it's time to go to class. All students must be dropped off at Entrance 1. If you plan to walk your child to class (MDO, Pre-K, and Kinder only), plan to arrive between 8:10 and 8:20. After 8:20, you must check in at the front desk with a valid driver's license. **Please note that after 8:30 am, no parents or visitors will be permitted to walk their child to class.**

Car Line Etiquette

When picking up your students, please remember to always have your yellow car sign visible. If you are picking up your child at walk up, please bring the sign with you. We ask that you obey traffic laws, such as no texting, slowing down for pedestrians, and that you follow traffic patterns. Both car lines **enter and exit facing Pearland Parkway**. All of these things ensure an efficient and safe dismissal for our students.



Lunch Accounts



Everything you need to know about your child's lunch can now be accessed through our website. *Clicking the picture to the left will take you where you need to go.* From here, you should be able to see the menu for this month, a link to add money to your child's account, and a link to check the

current balance. **Please note that checking the balance is completely separate from adding money.** The balance shown on the "Add Money" link **will not** reflect the actual balance of the lunch account.
